Entries will be taken on the day at £7.50 per class. Advance entries would be appreciated at £6.50 per class.

Friday 28th November, Friday 15th January

Clear Round Show Jumping – £3.00 per round.

Class 1. Double Clear Round Show Jumping (On/Off lead rein) – From 5pm.
Entry £6.50. All clear first rounds go through to un-timed jump off with equal first place awarded to all double clears, clear round rosettes to all others who go clear in the first round.

Class 2. The Asti Challenge – Entry £6.50.
Open to any horse/pony and rider. Height of course in first round 1'6" – 2'6" approx. All clear rounds will go forward to a timed jump off. Points from this class will be carried forward to the finals evening on March 20th, when the rider with the most points will be awarded the Challenge Trophy.

Class 3. Barrel Jumping – Entry £6.50.
Open to any horse/pony and rider. A class to test your accuracy, starting over 6 barrels and taking one away every time you jump clear.

Saturday 19th December, Friday 19th February and Saturday 20th March

Clear Round Show Jumping – £3.00 per round.

Class 1. Double Clear Round Show Jumping (On/Off lead rein) – Saturday shows start from 1pm, and Friday Shows start 5pm. Entry £6.50. All clear first rounds go through to un-timed jump off with equal first place awarded to all double clears, clear round rosettes to all others who go clear in the first round.

Class 2. The Asti Challenge – Entry £6.50.
Open to any horse/pony and rider. Height of course in first round 1'6" – 2'6" approx. All clear rounds will go forward to a timed jump off. Points from this class will be carried forward to the finals evening on March 20th, when the rider with the most points will be awarded the Challenge Trophy.

Class 3. Top Score – Entry £6.50.
Open to any horse/pony and rider. A class jumping a grid of 3 fences increasing in height every time you jump clear.
